Annotated Bibliography Assignment

Part I

Write a brief paragraph summarizing the major themes and concerns of the articles you used in the annotated bibliography. You should think of this as an intro to the assignment. You must describe your topic and, once again, connect the articles to the ways we are thinking about globalization in this class.

After the paragraph, you must reformulate your research question in one sentence.

Part II

Your annotated bibliography must include EIGHT different sources – these must be articles from academic, peer-reviewed journals. If you are unclear if you have chosen appropriate sources, check with me. Our library staff can direct you to the proper databases for searching. Newspapers, newsletters, magazines, and blogs are not appropriate sources for this assignment.

The best bibliographies will include a range of methodological and theoretical approaches. You should also include a wide range of authors – for this assignment, you may not repeat authors.

Please consult the links (on our site) regarding the scope of an annotated bibliography and its aim. The major work of the bibliography is researching and reading; writing is the end product of these processes.

Requirements

- Assignments must be around 5 to 6 pages, double-spaced, in 12 pt. font.
- Use 1-inch margins all around.
- Your name, the date, and the assignment (“Annotated Bibliography”) must appear at the top left corner, single-spaced.
- Be certain to check for spelling mistakes and typos before turning in the assignment.
- Attach the first page of each article you used to the back of the assignment.
- Attach the rubric to the back of your assignment.
- Staple all pages so nothing gets lost.
